

BUILDING A HONEYCOMB

DID YOU KNOW: Bees use wax to build their honeycombs? These honeycombs consist of many small wax cells. The queen bee lays her eggs in these cells, larvae develop in them, whilst others are used to store honey and pollen. Every cell has six sides.
